2.1 Discussion of 2020 Budget



Mr. Markham said we present this budget at the public hearing tonight and then we come back on October 22, 2019 to adopt with the board's vote. It would then be sent to the DLGF. They will tell us what the final budget will be.


With no further business, Mrs. Ayres, School Board President, adjourned the Manchester Community Schools' Board of Trustees Board Meeting at 5:33 p.m.








